Introductions & Affiliation's:

HMGP Grant update (Bethany Hand):

- The department of Public Safety Administration (PSA) will manage the LEPC grant
- Current grant runs through 2022
- Discussed building on the Chemical Emergency Response Plan (CERP) by moving into testing and training.
- Updating of CERP with flow study report and current threats
- Project would align with other city plans
- Bill Schatz
 - Inquired about any discussion by the state of reducing the amount of the grant. Bethany replied, not that she was aware of.
- Dan O'Connell
 - Requested a notation that the LEPC CRP was initiated for the Chemical Association in Chicago and should not dictate other city agencies responsibilities.
- Terry Sheahan
 - Suggested a small committee to work with Tom Sivak (OEMC) regarding Task of the Grant.
 - Small Committee members: Glen Lyman, Terry Sheahan, Chief Satriano, Bill Schatz, Bethany Hand, and Tom Sivak

HazMat update (Chief Satriano)

- Tier II Program

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- HazMat companies currently have no way to pull up fixed facility data
- Previous program for obtaining the data has stopped and moved to CPD platform
 - The CPD platform is not user friendly
- Terry Sheahan has reached out to IEMA to obtain password access for hazmat personnel
- Motion made to have small group sit down and discuss how to provide information
 - Committee members: Mike Sardo (CPIC), Chief Satriano (CFD), Terry Sheahan (CDPH), Tom Sivak (OEMC), Dan Casey (OEMC), and Joe Kaison (OEMC).

Update on Chemical Emergency Response Plan (Glen Lyman):

- Motion made to submit updated CERP to State. Second by Bill Schatz
 - Inquire with Jim Thompson regarding timeline of approval or disapproval
 - Chair Glen Lyman will forward CERP to Jim Thompson with IEMA

Tier II Mass Email Update (Terry Sheahan):

- Currently working on liquid waste
- Mass email should go out end of January and have until March 16 to respond
- 90% return on mailing
- Currently there are approximately 1,000 Tier II Facilities

- Bill Schatz inquired about any response from Mayor's office regarding LEPC letter forwarded by Chair Glen Lyman.
- Glen Lyman responded no response but would reach out to Alderman to inquire.
